

GĄSIENIEC MIROSŁAW Album for Children

CHILDREN SERIES: CAT PWM 12681



A collection of several piano pieces designed to encourage young pianists to develop their skills. The pieces are arranged by difficulty, allowing for gradual improvement in technique and musical sensitivity. This collection combines educational and artistic value, offering a variety of compositions that inspire learning and enjoyment at the piano.

Similar to the book no 1, included works are of a dance character, but this time they are artistic stylisations of Polish national dances. This set ends with a Highland dance, in which I used certain melodicharmonic-rhythmic elements to convey the character of folk music from the Podhale highland region.

This is a piano duet album comprising ten dance-inspired pieces. The pieces are designed for young piano students, combining a dance character with the educational benefits of ensemble playing.


CHILDREN SERIES: CAT PWM 13022



A collection of miniatures designed for beginner pianists. Each piece is based on five consecutive notes of a specific scale or key, but surprises with varied octave placements. This approach helps young musicians quickly learn to read notes on the staff, navigate the keyboard, and explore the piano's different registers.

The collection promotes the even development of finger technique, particularly for the fourth and fifth fingers, by systematically engaging all five fingers. Without traditional fingering indications, students are encouraged to assign fingers to specific notes, fostering better coordination between both hands. Each miniature is preceded by information about the key or scale used, enhancing the understanding of music theory. The edition includes an insert to help with finger-note assignments.

This is an excellent educational tool for teachers and an inspiring resource for young pianists eager to develop their skills in an engaging and enjoyable way.










GRABIŃSKI WŁODZIMIERZ Piano Miniatures

CHILDREN SERIES: CAT PWM 12379



A collection of 11 short pieces, perfect for children and young pianists. These compositions, with increasing levels of difficulty, are carefully crafted by a renowned piano educator to be engaging for both students and teachers. The pieces stand out for their sincere artistic expression, natural progression of tension, and clear melodic lines, making them accessible and enjoyable for young musicians.

Christmas Presents for piano

A set of six piano pieces first published in 1885, the only work that the composer wrote with young pianists in mind. Interestingly, there are no discernible references to Christmas in the music, and the title may be seen rather as a nineteenth-century marketing ploy, aimed at encouraging musicians to buy the music at Christmas time. The composer presents here graceful works with charming melodies and - for the most part - a dance character, which set a variety of challenges before the performer such as rapid passagework and varied articulation.



HANON CHARLES, HILL ROCH A Selection of Exercises for piano

SERIES: STRUMENTO

This selection of exercises was developed based on the popular collection by Ch.L. Hanon entitled Le pianiste - virtuose. The book contains 47 exercises, arranged in an order that conditions the correct development of finger technique. Contrary to Hanon's orginial, the sequential progressions of individual exercises are given within one octave, which is sufficient to extend the exercises to two or three octaves. Another novelty is also the introduction of characteristic rhythmic sequences in the final exercises.



The collection of pieces that are partially written in a conventional manner, where everything is fully notated, but they are enriched with short improvisational sections. In these sections, the performer has the opportunity to create their own melody to the pre-written left-hand accompaniment. Each Ideophony includes an improvisational section at the end with a ready-made melodic suggestion that can be incorporated into the entire composition. Therefore, these pieces can be treated as fully notated compositions or as a basis for adding one's own ideas.



In this selection, you can find diverse compositions, both in terms of style and level of difficulty. Pianists often show a clear interest in playing music that goes beyond the purely classical boundaries and Mołodyjki in its diversity offers such musical material. The collection includes both cantilena works and lively pieces perfecting the piano technique. Some require a purely classical approach in technical, sound and expressive terms, but many of them challenge the performer with articulation and rhythmic patterns. In this collection, pianists at a fairly early stage of learning as well as those more advanced will find something for themselves.

The executive edition with essays and critical commentary, authored by Agnieszka Budzińska--Bennett and Marc Lewon, created in cooperation with the PWM Edition and the Adam Mickiewicz Institute, is an edition of the musical part of the manuscript Rps 8054 III, commonly called Kras 52. The edition includes all the compositions contained in the manuscript as well as pieces preserved only fragmentarily, recorded in the manuscript in the margin as sketches, and in the transcription supplemented with possible implementation. Some of the compositions have a proposed alternative version that can be performed (with different texting, more emendations or a different implementation of ligatures). In individual works, comments are written in the margin describing the changes made by the authors of the edition compared to the manuscript. Each composition is accompanied by an essay on the history of the piece as well as the nature of the notation and the method of notation. The publication also includes: an introduction, short biographies of composers and poets, a glossary of terms used in the edition and the most up-to-date bibliography.

Musicologists commonly call it Kras 52 - after the former reference number it was given in the Krasiński Library. It is the most valuable Polish source of medieval polyphonic music, which shaped the soundscape of the court of the first Jagiellons and Kraków at that time. The manuscript is gaining new life now, thanks to a performance edition by Agnieszka Budzińska-Bennett and Marc Lewon. The Krasiński Codex has been published by PWM Edition with the support of the Adam Mickiewicz Institute. In this podcast, we will explore the uniqueness and cultural importance of the manuscript, the need for a new edition prepared with the performer in mind, as well as the recent concert life of its repertoire.


